

Remote Learning at Ilam CE Primary

As part of the school's remote learning policy there will be the following provision for Kingfishers and Squirrels.

- Access to the White Rose Maths resources for daily Maths
- An English activity for pupils to complete each day
- Handwriting activity to carry out each day
- A daily phonics activity for pupils in Squirrels
- Spellings will be set.
- A Science activity each week
- An activity linked to the topic each week
- A creative activity each week
- Where possible brief videos by class teachers will be e mailed to parents to introduce activities for the children as appropriate.
- The school will provide a pack of exercise books for pupils to complete their work, these should be collected from school this Thursday between 9.30am and 2pm.
- This will include a blank book with an A4 sheet inside it is for pupils to work on project of their own choosing- e.g. Horses, Dancing, The Farm, Space etc. Use the blank piece of paper to stick on for your front cover.

Hedgehogs

- There will be an input of stories from Miss Goldstraw and an opportunity for pupils to share their news via zoom.
- Where possible brief videos by staff will be e mailed to parents to introduce activities for the children as appropriate.
- Activities to support pupil's phonics development
- Activities to support pupils' writing development
- Activities to support pupils' development in Maths
- More wide-ranging play ideas and activities

Parental Support

- We would ask parents to scan/ e mail or photograph pupils' work at the end of the week to support assessment and feedback for the following subjects- Maths, English, Science, Topic, Creative.
- We would ask parents to hear children every day, access to reading will be through parents returning/collecting new books each week. Timings for this will follow next week.
- We would also ask parents to practice counting, number bonds and X tables with their children.
