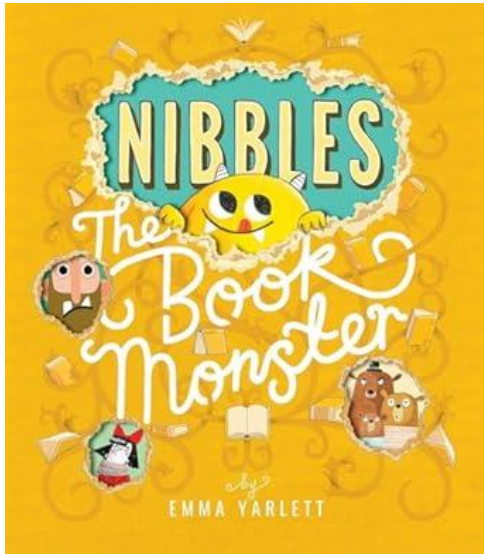




English

Year 1: Money and Time

Religious Education

Our focus for RE this half term is 'How Can I Make a Difference in the World?'. The children will look at Christian examples of how to make an impact on the world.



Science

Years 1 and 2: Living things and their habitats: This topic will cover the different types of living things, such as plants and animals, and the specific habitats they need to survive. Students will explore how these habitats provide essential resources like food, water, shelter, and the right conditions for growth and reproduction.

Years 3 and 4: Animals including humans: This topic will cover various aspects of animals and humans, including their life cycles, body parts, and functions. Students will explore how animals and humans grow, develop, and reproduce, as well as the importance of nutrition and exercise for maintaining a healthy body.

These topics will be enhanced by our class trip to the National Forest Adventure Farm where we will be doing an animal themed workshop.

History

Our topic this term is Nurturing Nurses. We will focus on the influential individuals who shaped the profession, alongside the evolution of healthcare, including the NHS. This topic explores key figures like Florence Nightingale, Mary Seacole, and Edith Cavell.



PSHE

Our topic this half term is Diverse Britain. Exploring the world in which we live.

Design and Technology

Our learning will involve creating a monster with moving parts! The children will plan and design their own monster, then bring them to life!



Computing

This half term we will focus on keyboard skills, learning where the all the letters are in order to begin the skill of touch typing. Computing will also be incorporated into other lessons such as English.
